The Olaf award is designed to recognize members who have developed digital/virtual cultural programs that have been utilized by a lodge either by ZOOM or at an in-person meeting.

Criteria

- 1. Creativity
- 2. Relevance to Norwegian and/or Scandinavian Culture and Heritage
- 3. Format and Clarity
- 4. Quality
- 5. Program to have been created in the biennium since the last convention

Submissions will include:

- The program title and topic
- Lodge name
- Name(s) of person or persons who created the electronic program
- Length of program
- Date the program was presented to the lodge

Submission process:

- All entries will be submitted electronically by May 1 of the convention year.
- Submissions will be sent to the district cultural director, <u>culturaldirector@sofn6.org</u>.
- An electronic copy of the program file will be sent to the district webmaster, <u>webmaster@sofn6.org</u>.
- Submissions will be posted on the District Six Convention website for viewing prior to the convention.

Award process:

- Submissions will be shown in the Folk Art room during the convention.
- Convention attendees may select their favorite digital/electronic program voting to be set up and administered by the Folk Art Committee.
- The Olaf award will be presented at the biennial District Six Lodge Meeting and Convention.
- Submitted programs may be presented in part or in full at the District Six Lodge Meeting and Convention and/or posted electronically prior to and after the Convention.
