Reason for this program:

- 2) There is a no minute time limit to get 20 signatures. Take your time and visit with people. There is no credit for speed!
- 3) For the first 10 minutes people with names beginning with A-M move around the room. Everyone else stay seated and let people come to you. After 10 minutes, switch groups.
- 4) There may be a square or two where no one there fits the category.
